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**CARTER CREEK WINERY EARNS 11 MEDALS
AT SAN FRANCISCO CHRONICLE WINE COMPETITION**

JOHNSON CITY, Texas (January 21, 2020) – Carter Hospitality Group, LLC proudly announces its [Carter Creek Winery](#) in the heart of Texas Hill Country garnered 11 prestigious awards at the 2020 San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition, which took place January 7 to 10 with over 65 judges representing various North American wine regions evaluating nearly 6,700 wines from over 1,000 wineries.

“These recent wine citations from the San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition are very meaningful to us as the award-winning wines are given wide recognition, including being published in the wine award special section of the *San Francisco Chronicle* newspaper and the receipt of plaques for silver, gold and double gold medals that Carter Creek Winery earned – medals we will proudly showcase in our brand new tasting rooms,” said Jeff Carter, president of Carter Hospitality.

Noted by veteran master winemaker Jon McPherson, who oversees production of Carter Creek’s award-winning wines, its vineyards in Texas Hill Country produce varietals especially unique due to the combination of an extremely warm growing season and an early harvest delivering softer, earth driven wines.

The 2020 San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition Awards for Carter Creek Winery included the prestigious Double Gold medal for *2017 Grenache Rosé* and a Double Gold for *Sparkling Peach*, as well as Gold medal for *2016 Plateau Red*. The competition also cited seven Carter Creek varietals with Silver medals, and one of its wines won a Bronze.

The San Francisco Chronicle Wine Competition is currently the largest wine competition in North America and is open to all bonded wineries in the United States, Canada and Mexico. Over 65 prestigious experts within the trade, media, hospitality and education industries from around the wine regions of the country join to offer a diversity of expertise to each judging panel.

Producing award-winning wines since 2016, Carter Creek Winery recently moved its wine production facilities from Lubbock to Johnson City along Old Hwy 290 to complement the new Carter Creek Winery Resort & Spa opening soon. Counterpart to Temecula’s award-winning South Coast Winery Resort & Spa and Carter Estate Winery and Resort, the new luxury resort will feature 78 luxury villas, a spa, tasting rooms, restaurant, its own onsite microbrewery creating small batch craft beers and an outdoor event center, which will feature top musical acts.
